And if you're looking for a smaller get together – perhaps a children's party – then the **Steam Hall Gallery** is an ideal option.



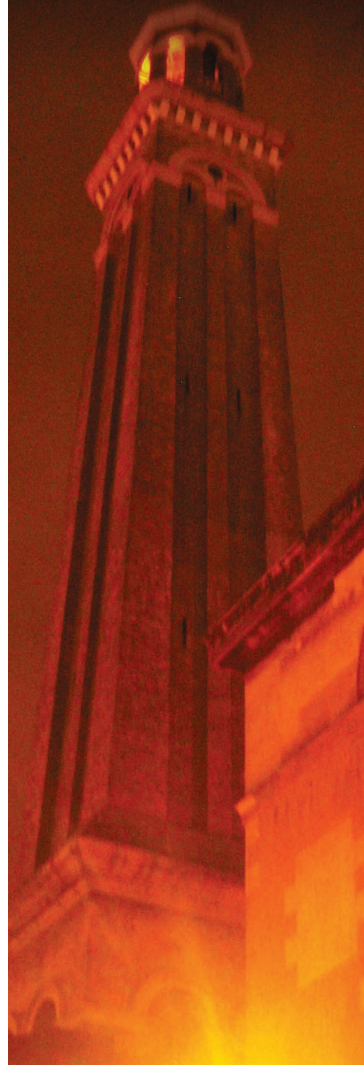
## Something different for corporate customers

**Parking:** the car park is free and has spaces for 40 cars or 2 coaches.

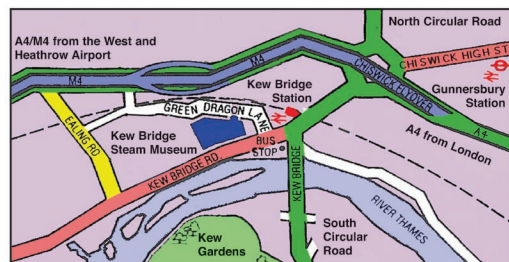
**Rail:** Kew Bridge station is only 5 minutes walk away and just 30 minutes by train from Waterloo or 20 minutes from Clapham Junction.
